
DECREE No. 2020/317 OF 22 JUNE 2020 to dismiss Dr. SANGO Martin NDEH from the Higher Education corps

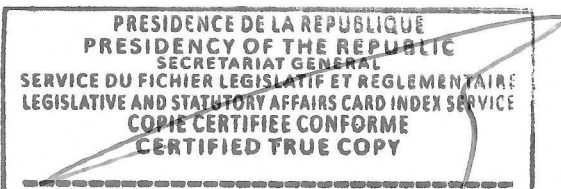

Considering the minutes of the Disciplinary Board held at the University of Buea on 25 March 2020, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Higher Education,

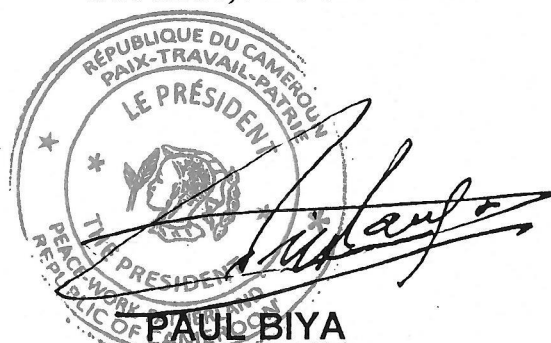
HEREBY DECREES AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1: Pursuant to the provisions of Articles 49 and 50 of Decree No. 93/27 of 19 January 1993, **Dr. SANGO Martin NDEH**, Lecturer at the Faculty of Arts of the University of Buea, is, with effect from the date of signature of this decree, dismissed from the Higher Education corps, without suspension of pension rights, for attempting to obstruct the smooth conduct of resit examinations organized in the said faculty during the 2018/2019 academic year and for repeatedly committing acts likely to impede the normal and smooth functioning of the faculty.

ARTICLE 2: This decree shall be registered, published according to the procedure of urgency, and inserted in the Official Gazette in English and French.
